



## STANDING ORDER INFORMATION

Setting up a SO is a simple, safe and convenient way to manage your monthly fees from your bank or building society account. You agree with TSWPC the amount to be collected and the date of payment. From then on the amount will be deducted from your account as agreed. If TSWPC need to change the amount or collection date, we will notify you first.

### Payment Dates

Your SO should ideally be set up to come out on the **1<sup>st</sup> of every month**. If your child starts their training with TSWPC mid-month, you can make a one-off payment to cover this period which your contact will provide you with.

#### **NOTE: Club Constitution guidelines**

**5.1** A member wishing to resign membership of the Club must give to the Secretary **1 months** written notice of his/her resignation. A member's resignation shall only take effect when agreed by the Committee, when there is no outstanding financial commitment or disciplinary action outstanding against the individual, when all perpetual trophies held by the individual have been returned and this Rule 5.1 has been complied with.

**5.2** A member who resigns from the Club in accordance with Rule 5.1 above shall not be entitled to have any part of the annual membership fee or any other fees returned.

**5.3** Notwithstanding the provisions of Rule 5.1 a member whose subscription has not been received by 1st December shall be deemed to have resigned. Where the membership of a member shall be terminated in this way, he/she shall be informed in writing that he/she is no longer a member by notice to him/her or sent by post to his/her last known address.

**5.4** The Swim England (ASA) Membership Department shall be informed should a member resign when owing money, or goods, to the club.
